

Manufacturer's Certification Statement

Effective with the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022

This Manufacturer's Certification Statement can be relied upon by taxpayers for verification that certain Windsor Windows & Doors products are eligible for certain tax credits identified in section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code as amended by the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022. These Energy Efficient Home Improvement Credits are set to expire on December 31st, 2025 as a part of the One Big Beautiful Bill Act (OBBBA) of 2025.

The IRS requires that the manufacturer be identified. Windsor Windows & Doors, a division of Woodgrain Inc., is headquartered at the following address: Windsor Windows & Doors, 900 South 19th Street, West Des Moines, IA 50265.

The IRS also requires a 4-digit Qualified Manufacturer ID (QMID) number from a manufacturer of eligible energy-efficient home improvement products. The QMID number for Windsor Windows & Doors is "**Y2R8**".

All exterior windows and doors that meet the following criteria are eligible to receive a tax credit:

- **Exterior Windows** that meet **ENERGY STAR Most Efficient** qualifications. The tax credit is limited to 30% of the cost of the qualified product, with a \$600 limit.
- **Exterior Doors** that meet qualifications for **ENERGY STAR** version 6.0 prior to October 23, 2023, and **ENERGY STAR** version 7.0 on or after October 23, 2023, for the climate zone they are installed in. The tax credit is limited to 30% of the cost of the product, \$250 maximum per door with a total of \$500.

To qualify for the tax credit homeowners must:

- Purchase qualifying products and have them installed in the taxpayer's primary residence.
- Save your product receipts, NFRC product labels for each qualifying product and this Manufacturer's Certification Statement.
